We are now in the season of darkness, yet we are comforted by the Light (and lights) of Christmas. Most of the year, the view from our apartment is rather unappealing. Almost all we can see is the six story hotel next door. However, at Christmas time, almost every window of the hotel has a bright, lighted Christmas star hanging in it making the view much more enjoyable.

PRISON OUTREACH

Every other Thursday, Chris and Gage minister to those in the local prison. This ministry has seen the Gospel shared to men from all over Greenland and now even from other countries. There are two young men in the prison, neither of which are Greenlandic nor speak the language. However, they both speak English. Both young men were originally cold and uninterested. But recently, they have begun to open up more. The one young man, a Muslim, asked a bunch of questions about the Bible and then asked if he could have one. Chris gave him a Bible this last week as well as a reading plan. When the other young man, a native Spanish speaker, saw the Muslim getting a Bible, he asked if he could have one in Spanish! Pray for these young men to get saved.

HYMNAL UPDATE

In our last letter, we reported that the hymnals were on their way to us. It is such a joy to have them in hand now and be actively using them. We want to add our thanks to our sending church, Lakewood Baptist Church in Harrison, Tennessee, which since our last letter also gave towards the costs of the hymnals.

LOOKING AHEAD

We are excited to share that we will, Lord willing, be taking a **furlough** in 2026. We will be back February 9th to the 1st of May. Our original plan was to come back for six months, but that changed when we discovered that our residence permit would only allow us out of the country for three months at a time. That being said, we plan to make the most of it and visit as many supporting churches as we can during this short time. We currently have meetings in the Tennessee and Virginia area as well as in Oklahoma and a few surrounding states. We still have a few dates available, so if any of our supporting churches would like us to come and give an update, please reach out to us.

LANGUAGE CLASSES

Gage's third Greenlandic course is underway. It is a six-week course with one class a week. Each class runs for two hours which means that a lot of

information is packed into a short amount of time. As always, we greatly appreciate your prayers for our understanding and growth in this complicated language.

VISA RENEWAL

Back in August, we reapplied for our yearly residence visa. If everything had gone smoothly, we would have received them the first of November, but, as is very common, the process did not go smoothly. The government erroneously thought that Aleah had left the country and that certain requirements on Gage's visa weren't met. We provided the information needed namely stating that Aleah had **not** left the country and presenting the documentation showing that the requirements for Gage's visa **had been** met. We are praising the Lord that our information was accepted and our visas have now been approved!

Once again, we want to say thank you for your faithful prayers and support of us and the ministry here in Greenland. And we want to say a special thank you to each one who has given a Christmas offering; it is such a blessing to us!
