Dear Church,

Since December 2025, we have witnessed significant progress and growth within our congregation. New converts are being discipled, and faithful members are stepping up and taking initiative in many areas. The week before Christmas, we hosted a special event that welcomed approximately 700 visitors! This provided everyone in the church with a wonderful opportunity to engage in evangelistic outreach, resulting in many new contacts to follow up with in the weeks that followed.

As we entered January, we did a special new year service filled with testimonies set around a bonfire. A Couple weeks later we held a three-day conference featuring a longtime friend of our family, Pastor Raul Reyes from Mexico. The response from our families was truly tremendous, and it was a time of great encouragement and spiritual renewal. Just before the conference, the Lord graciously answered our prayers regarding our search for a property. We were able to make a down payment, and we are now at 65% of the funds needed to complete the purchase by July. With our storefront lease expiring in June, our second anniversary falling in the last week of the same month, and the deadline to pay off the property by July, these three notable moments in the calendar have aligned in a remarkable way. Our plan is to inaugurate our first service on the new property on the Sunday of our second anniversary.

Currently, the property has structures that can be used for an auditorium, classrooms, and office space, though all of them require renovation. We are actively working on these renovations, and Lord willing, hope to have them completed by May. In February, we held our Valentine's couples banquet on the 13th, with 10 couples attending. These couples represent some of our most dedicated families, and the event was a wonderful opportunity for everyone to deepen their relationships and fellowship together.

We are grateful for your continued prayers and support as we move forward in faith, trusting God for the completion of these projects and for the ongoing growth of our church family.
