We wanted to share an encouraging report from our ministry partners in Zambia and thank you for your continued prayers and support. God is moving in powerful ways through the faithful preaching of His Word.

Recently, Evangelist Derick Kapijimpanga shared the following update from Kasabwa Bible Baptist Church in Mulofwa District, Masaiti:

“We remain resolute to soul winning, for this is the burden and calling that has been placed on our lives. We had such a powerful time at Kasabwa Bible Baptist Church where many endured the cold night to hear the Gospel. We saw many people rededicate themselves to the Lord, and approximately 11 people

trusted Christ as Savior.

It was an honor to minister alongside Pastor Mubanga of Telesha Bible Baptist Church and Pastor Moses Ilunga of Faith Baptist Church, Ibenga.

Please continue praying with us. Many are hungry for Jesus, but the laborers are few. Though we are serving under difficult circumstances, the love of God and the calling upon our lives compel us to keep going.

We ask you to join us in prayer. If you are able to come and serve, we welcome you. If you are able to give, please consider helping us continue this work, for the call to preach Christ belongs to every believer.”

In addition, we received another report following a market outreach in Ibenga:

“We had a market outreach with over 300 people in attendance. By God’s grace, 55 adults accepted Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, and 40 children made professions of faith. We had such a blessed night. Please continue praying for us. Any support to help facilitate transportation and ministry efforts is greatly appreciated.”
