Back at Breck Road, the Lord provided brand-new metal fencing to replace the old, crumbling one around the church. Several volunteers gave of their time and strength to dig posts and set panels. By the end of the week the work was complete! Already the new fence has been a testimony, sparking conversations with neighbours who are curious about the church; not to mention a lot safer.

Then came Camp Victory. This year's theme was "Through God we shall do valiantly" (Psalm 60:12), and it was one of the best years yet. We were thrilled to take nearly 50 young people and workers from our church, including a child from the new Norris Green plant! Many of our people served as tent leaders and helpers. Throughout the two weeks we rejoiced to see several of our Breck Road young people responding to the gospel. Our boys greatly enjoyed being part of the Day Camp during the 2 weeks—and little Elsie had the time of her life being carried from one activity to another!

This was a wonderful 3-days of reuniting with Christian friends from across the country, being challenged in the Word of God. The boys enjoyed being part of the children's programme and were able to sing in a children's choir on the last day of the conference. // The toddler group and English classes have started back after having taken a break during the Summer months. The first English class was full and an additional table had to be set out to accommodate the students who came. We are thankful for the Youth Rally starting back, as well, with a good number coming out to the first Friday back. The Norris Green Bible club started back, as well, after having been off due to the weeks of Camp Victory. 19 children came to the first club back; one young person was new from the door knocking that Wesley did with one of the Crown Hall students! What an answer to prayer. The Sunday School continued through the Summer but fluctuated in attendance with family holidays. But we are thankful that now that schools are back in session, all of our young people are back in town. Just the other week we saw 91 young people attend! Praise the Lord. It is such a joy to see many young families and others helping with driving, teaching, registration, organisation, set up and clean up and more. We're blessed with a working church whose heartbeat is being trained to reach the next generation with the gospel. As we gear up for the Autumn and all it holds, we are grateful for God's blessing and prayerfully expect even greater things from Him in the days ahead.

We are so thankful to one of our generous supporting churches who graciously provided the entire monetary amount needed to see this happen! We have completed all the necessary paperwork and are waiting for the biometrics appointment. After that, we must wait for the answer/verdict. Please pray that there are no issues with their applications and for a quick verdict (they say it can take up to 6 months!).

(2) Baby #4 and Joy's Health

We are so thankful for God gifting us with another child due in March 2026. Please pray for strength for Joy and continued health throughout her pregnancy, as well as for the safe development of baby.

(3) National Youth Rally

Please pray for the upcoming National Youth Rally in October. This is a time where many of the churches who had their young people attend Camp Victory in the Summer come back together for fellowship, activities and a time of preaching.

(4) Missions Conference
