It is the honor of our lives to serve our King as missionaries. As His precious Word goes out, countless lives are being transformed throughout the world; we have watched our wonderful Lord working: many broken homes restored, many individual lives transformed, from meaningless to meaningful lives. Some were ready to take their lives are now experiencing abundant life; young people waiting on the Lord to marry the one He has for them; parents learning to love and discipline their children according to His Word, etc. It is amazing to bring His Word to the deaf and hearing wherever we go. It is all about our wonderful Savior!

We had been praying and preparing for our furlough; God has been working in a wonderful way in our nephew Jonathan's heart since we started the work in the jungle for the past 3 1/2 years; the last 2 years Raymond trained him in different ways, especially in the area of preaching and teaching the deaf in church and school. Praise the Lord Jonathan has been outstanding in his attitude and learning; he is signing and voicing his messages. God is giving him and his family a heart for the deaf and people in general. Glory to God!

Before our trip back to the USA. We traveled to Huancayo to help with the deaf ministry; then, we had doctors appointments in Lima. Raymond has been losing his eyesight gradually; he preaches with PowerPoint on a TV screen. The geriatric doctor told us although Raymond's MRIs shows normal aging of his brain, being deaf, he has depended on his eyesight all his life and the reason he forgets more is that he has developed a Disconnection Syndrome due to losing his vision. Also, in the last few months Raymond's back had been bending sideways, the orthopedic surgeon found that he has a fractured L4 which has caused a very bad scoliosis. Raymond needs back surgery to correct that. The doctor said it was a risky operation. Our great desire is to serve the Lord as missionaries for the rest of our lives. We have given all to the Lord and taking it one day at a time, constantly reminding ourselves that God's love for us is always the same no matter the circumstances. Now in the USA, before we do anything we need to focus on Raymond's health. Please pray for the Lord's leading and healing in His will. Pray for Paul as he will start Bible College. GOD IS GOOD!

While in Lima the Lord gave us the joy of leading five people to Him: three taxi drivers, a deaf older lady and our neurologist at the hospital. They all thanked us for sharing the good news with them. The neurologist told us, "God brought you here for me today." We told her that our appointment with her was her appointment with God. She shed tears. It is all about HIM!

Our churches in Ecuador and Peru are taking care of their own needs and their missionary support as Raymond passionately taught them, thank the Lord. The deaf schools the Lord burdened us to start as ministry of our churches, have been a great tool to teach the students the Word of God every day; the deaf students learn to read and understand the Word faster than the deaf who only attend church once or twice a week. We share this to thank everyone of you who invest in supporting this precious deaf school ministry in Ecuador and Peru. Please continue to pray and give to keep the schools open until the Lord's return.
