
At present, we are still able to enter Malaysia without much questioning, unlike our previous field in Sri Lanka. Out of seven missionaries (to my knowledge), only one has obtained a longer-term visa known as the MM2H. The rest of us continue to go in and out of the country, as even working visas are becoming increasingly tight and restrictive, especially in Mainland Malaysia. This neglected neighbor of our homeland, the Philippines, needs much prayer.

Malaysian law restricts Muslims from converting to Christianity or any other religion, while non-Muslims are generally free to embrace the Christian faith. These restrictions arise from Malaysia's dual legal system: civil law, which guarantees freedom of religion under Article 11 of the Federal Constitution, and Syariah law, which governs Muslims and prohibits apostasy. In this context, our mission remains clear: to build friendships and win souls one at a time. As Paul wrote, "To the weak became I as weak, that I might gain the weak: I am made all things to all men, that I might by all means save some" (1 COR. 9:22).

This quarter, I have prepared five Gospel tracts, praying that the Lord will use one of them to speak to hearts. We are trusting God for ₱25,000.00 to cover the initial printing costs.

After celebrating the Christmas season in the Philippines with our children, we are scheduled to return to our mission field on January 30, 2026. Please also pray for favorable results in our upcoming medical check-up next week.

May the Lord continue to bless my supporting churches and praying friends. He will reward you in His perfect time.
