Oh, the joys of church planting! There is excitement as our national pastors in northern Kenya have targeted a couple more villages for new churches. The village pictured below is named Lokichar. After preaching, many turned to Jesus as Savior and over 40 were baptized!



I truly believe 2026 is going to be an exciting year! We are already seeing doors opening in these nomadic areas. Years ago when we first arrived, a traditional Turkana tribal woman (like the one pictured below left) would never agree to baptism, but now, it is a common occurrence. The Gospel truly takes down cultural barriers! God has blessed our former ministries in Kenya with 541

decisions for Christ this past year and just over 100 baptized!

Overall throughout Africa, our BIMIA missionaries saw almost 23,000 receive Christ, 9 new churches planted, and nearly 400 national men and women in training! It was an amazing 2025, and we are anticipating even greater things this year! Already I am in communication with several young people expressing a God-given call to serve in Africa and a need to survey parts of the Continent.

Pray for open doors across Africa! With the current political climate, many of our missionaries are finding it



difficult to update their immigration status in certain countries. There are also hostile governments giving financial assistance and military hardware to some African governments which is

straining relations with the US government. Although the missionaries are not fearful, they are concerned and ask for more prayer. Let's all labor together in prayer for the cause of the Gospel in Africa!
