We are grateful to be among our people again. When we returned, attendance had dropped, so we are working to get everyone back in church and reach new people with the Gospel. We are encouraged by the

faithful brethren who served in various ministries during our absence and showed maturity and steadfastness.

We have been doing outreach events to connect with new individuals. One special event was a new-moms gathering hosted by the ladies, with help from a medical missionary. Many teen moms attended. We provided items for their babies and shared the Gospel. One mom has begun attending church, and we are praying the Gospel takes root in her heart.

By God's grace, we raised \$90,100 for our building project, bringing us to 72% of our goal. We hit the ground running upon arrival. The walls are up, concrete is being poured for the 18 columns for the second floor, and the church kitchen is almost completed. We look forward to sharing a video update soon.
