Celebrating 10 Years in England!

Dear Praying Family and Friends,

The past three months since our last update have been a whirlwind of ministry and big life events. We are excited to share with you these updates and they encourage you, too!

March marked 10 years since we began ministering in England. What an amazing 10 years it has been, too. Praise the Lord. In our last prayer letter, we asked prayer for the [Spring National Youth Rally](#). We are thankful to share that the afternoon event was greatly blessed. Not only did several churches from across England and Wales gather with their young people for a time of fellowship and recreation, but the gospel went forth through preaching, as well. We were able to take down many of our young people and several of our youth workers. That next Sunday was our [church anniversary](#). It is hard to believe that it has been nine years since the beginning of Breck Road Baptist Church here in Liverpool, England! We followed the anniversary service with a church-wide family dinner. The food and fellowship were amazing. Reminiscing, we cannot deny the hand of God as stories of answered prayer, changed lives and miraculous provision were remembered. We are trusting Him for even more in the next 9 years! In March we celebrated [Joy's birthday](#) and [Elsie's second birthday](#). We are navigating the twos and toilet-training days with laughter and patience. We are grateful for her life and the pure joy that she adds to our family. Another birthday in March was that of our second daughter and fourth child, [Lilias Jane](#). Though four days late, she made a quick, safe arrival at 8lbs 7oz. Joy began contractions at 4:30 on the Tuesday morning, we arrived to hospital by 7:30am, she was born at 9:18am and by 4:30 that evening, we were on our way home to introduce Lilias Jane to her three excited siblings and Joy's parents (who had kindly come over to help us during that time). Lilias' birth date was also the first evening of the Holiday Bible Club (Vacation Bible School) at Breck Road. It was *also* the same day that we received a massive shipping container to the church for the purpose of storage. Needless to say, March 31st was a busy day! We are thankful for the [Holiday Bible Club at Breck Road](#) this Spring. With Joy being out due to the baby and Jared being back and forth from family and the church during that week, it was a blessing to see our church family rise to the occasion, leading in and taking on responsibilities in areas and ways that perhaps they hadn't needed to in the past. We are so thankful that God has given us a sweet church family that provided meals all during this busy season for our family. Praise the Lord for nearly 140 young people attending HBC with several having continued to come to the Sunday school.

The month of **April** was welcomed with the celebration of the Lord's [Resurrection weekend](#)! We were able to hold Good Friday Gospel Services at Breck Road and at the second church plant in Norris Green. Both of those meetings were very well attended. The gospel went out clearly and many good conversations were shared afterwards around cups of tea and hot cross buns. Easter Sunday was also special as we had one of the first British Crown Hall trainees and "Team Liverpool", Danny Ahir, as a guest speaker. He is currently pastoring a CCHT church plant near London. The Monday after Easter Sunday, we went into our [second Holiday Bible Club](#), but this time at Norris Green. Over 70 children came throughout the week. We are thankful that people from Breck Road were able to help at the Holiday Bible Club at Norris Green, as well. Many families came out on the evening of the award ceremony creating a packed room! The children received awards for Scripture memory, cheering, team spirit, and more. Following the Holiday Bible Club at Norris Green, Jared was able to fly to America to be at the [Bible Conference](#) at our home church, Temple Baptist Church in Powell, Tennessee. He was honoured to have a part in the meetings as well as be able to meet potential students who are planning to come and study at Crown College UK. Upon his return, we helped to host the [Crown Hall graduation](#) in Droitwich (at Crown Hall), which was the closing for the term here in England. Two of the trainees have completed their training and are seeking the Lord for His wisdom and direction for the future. Jared took the US and European students to London that following week for a bit of sightseeing before they flew back to the States.

May was welcomed with a [work week at Crown Hall](#). This was a 3-day work opportunity to prepare for Camp Victory. The following week Jared was able to travel to Canada for the [Niagra Bible Conference](#), hosted by Kendall Wadley. Upon his return he was able to preach at a [gospel tent mission](#) at a church plant in Welshpool, Wales. May was a very big month for the Crown Christian Heritage Trust as it was the month of the annual [Sunday School Day and Parade](#). Typically, the Sunday School Day and Parade is held each year in either Birmingham or Gloucester. But this year the event was split into three regional locations: the South, the West Midlands and the North. The North location was to be at our church here in Liverpool. Much vital preparation was needed in order for the day to go smoothly. Therefore, much of the weeks and days leading up to Saturday, 23 May (the day of the parade) was spent in communication with various council members of the city, putting posters down the high street and in shops, gathering barriers and equipment to close down roads, walking the parade route multiple times to ensure safety and thoroughness. The fire department, police department and several other departments that we didn't even know existed were all in contact with us discussing the possibility of pulling off such a big feat. Our church location sits on a main vein that goes through a predominant area in Anfield (where the Liverpool Football Club is located). We were needing to close off Breck Road and a lot of smaller, connecting roads so that the parade could march all the way from our church to a local field/park. To say much prayer went into this day is an understatement. Our church people were excited and rallied in a remarkable way. We rejoice today in how God truly answered prayer, met with us and blessed the Sunday School Day in the Parade! Over 300 people from the North regions converged on Breck Road and Anfield. The parade down the high street of the Anfield area was mostly warmly accepted—shop owners and pedestrians waving and filming. It was a huge impact for our local area and for our church. Following that Saturday, 9 new children signed up for Sunday School and have been attending faithfully! Last week they all received their Bibles as a reward for having attended 3 weeks in a row. Praise the Lord!

OUTDOOR PROJECT

Even path & outdoor garden space

A man in our church has volunteered to help pull up and reposition all of the concrete pavers that lead up the walkway to the church. Right now they are major tripping hazards as tree roots have caused them to shift over time. During a work week at the church in July this project, as well as an outdoor play/garden area for the children, will be completed. What a blessing! Please pray for no complications and safety.

The Bible Club at Norris Green is also doing very well. The Holiday Bible Club really helped give that a boost. We are seeing new children come in and friends of children, and the new children from the door-knocking efforts, and we are thankful for that as well.

We kicked off the month of **June** with the **Appleby Horse Fair**. This is a gathering of Irish travellers that meet in the Lake District (about two hours away from us) to race their horses. Jared and Wesley were able to drive up to the large field to help set up a meeting marquee that was used for the gospel services. The Appleby Horse Fair is always a tremendous gospel opportunity. It has been able to reach into a community of people that sometimes aren't the most welcome. How wonderful that the gospel reaches to all and that all are invited to "taste and see that the Lord is good". Jared was privileged to speak on the Friday evening. An unfortunate situation took place early this month when Jared experienced **a severe gallbladder attack** on a Saturday night. A friend was able to come stay with the children whilst Joy took him to the emergency room. After a long, 11-hour visit, it was concluded that he will inevitably need to have his gallbladder removed. An appointment with the surgeon to discuss this is in July. Please pray he does not have any more attacks. If you have ever gone through one yourself you can understand just how awful this was! This month we are looking forward to hosting our **first men's camping trip**. This will be a time when the men in our church will gather for an overnight camping trip in the Lake District. In addition to a hike and canoeing, there is a planned time of preaching and prayer, hymn singing and testimonies. We look forward to seeing how the Lord will use this to encourage and unify the men of our church.

It is incredible to reflect on this Spring season and recognise the answers to prayer and miraculous doors that He's opened. We feel His sustaining strength has been even more evident in these months, because in the midst of the "bigger" events mentioned, all of our usual weekly and monthly ministries have still been taking place, as well.

A family from the **playgroup** has begun to attend the Sunday school. We have held the monthly **home-ed group** and have seen God use that ministry to bring families to our church and to the Sunday school. We're also thankful for the continued work of the **University Bible Study**. In our last prayer letter, we shared how God had opened a door for that after about 7 years of praying. It's come to a brief pause for the summer as the students are back in their respective homes. God willing, it will resume in the Autumn. In addition to the University Bible Study, we have a bi-weekly **Young Adult Fellowship**. These two ministries have been used to open up amazing doors of conversation concerning the gospel and living a genuine Christian life. They have strengthened the young adults in our church making provision for developing relationships and friendships. The **Sunday School** is continuing to grow with nearly a hundred young people attending. The volunteer workforce that God has given to labour in this ministry is a source of encouragement and praise. The Sunday lunches shared by the workers nine years ago consisted of our family and perhaps three others. Now we joke that Breck Road is a small restaurant on Sunday afternoons! After a bit of organising and logistics, nearly 40 people (workers and their children) eat lunch together every Sunday. These people are the bus drivers and riders, the Sunday school teachers. They're the people that help tear down and set up. They're the ones that help wash the dishes. It is truly amazing to see the army of Christians that God has given to this ministry and the heart they are developing for reaching the next generation with the gospel. The **Men's Breakfasts** have been a blessing and a challenge to the status quo of biblical manhood. We're thankful that the men in our church have been rising up and leading more, not only in their homes but in the church. Looking out at the congregation that gathers for the **Sunday and Wednesday services**, we continually see new families, university students, international students and families, people who have found us on online, people from the open air or door knocking efforts..Whilst being grateful for the increase God has given, we also carry the weight of being responsible for these souls who have been entrusted to our care. Please pray for us. God-willing in the next few weeks we will be having a baptism service for 3 ladies. Please pray for this, as well.

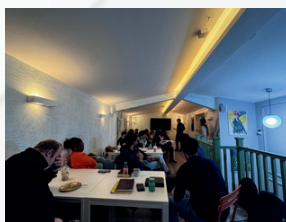

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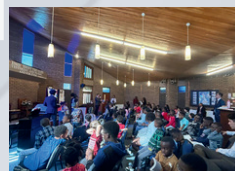
