## A FAMILY UPDATE

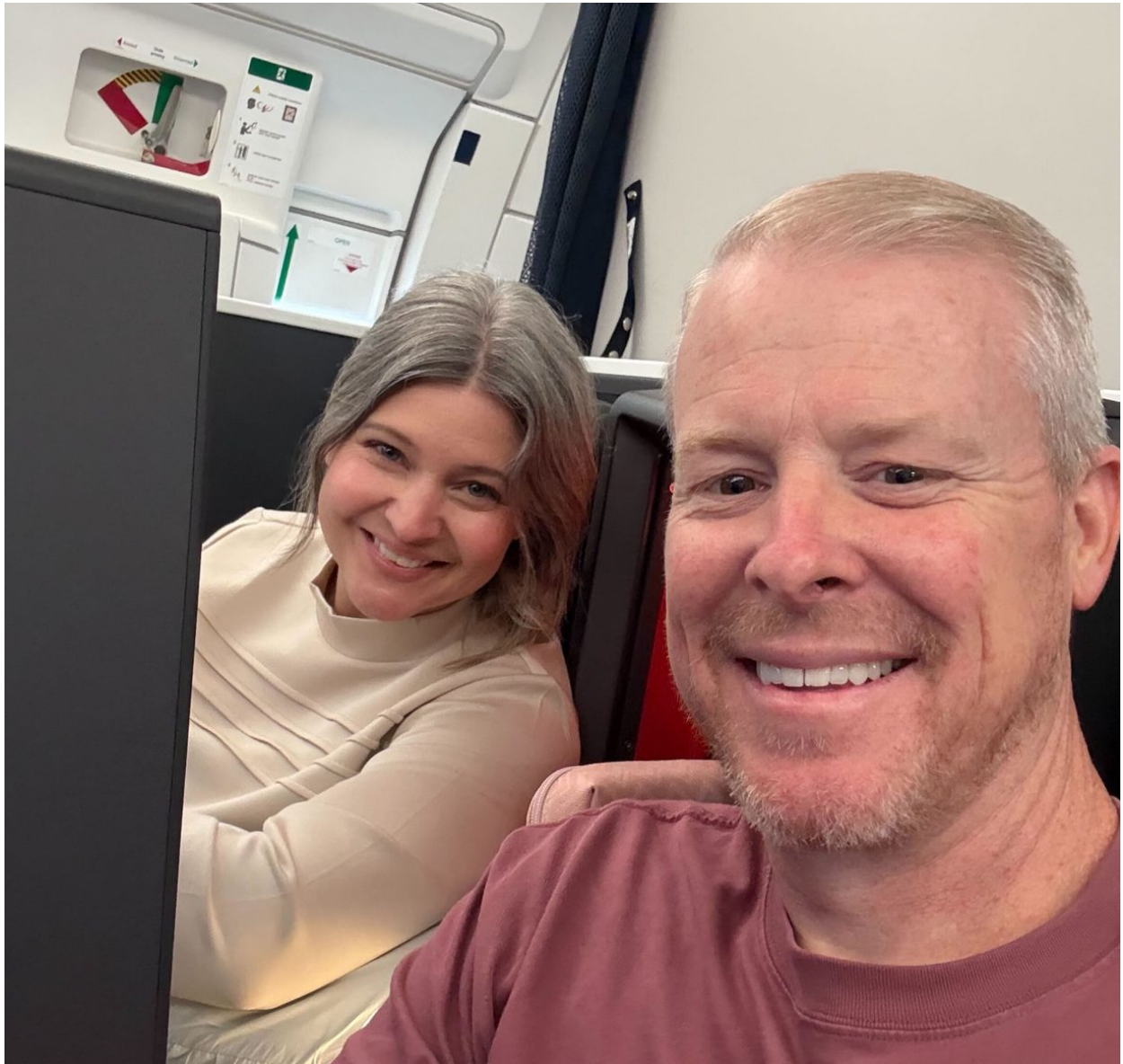
On the family front, we have much to celebrate as well.
