Dear family and friends in Christ:

"Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen" Ephesians 3:21.
We give Him the glory for who He is and for what he does, saving sinners like us all around the world. **MERRY CHRISTMAS!** With love from us.

By God's grace my wife celebrated 52 years as a child of God on October 4. The Lord used her oldest sister, Haydee, who is in heaven now, and the Whitherells, BIMI missionaries, to bring my wife to our precious Savior. Thank the Lord for those precious servants. Now my wife and I have the honor of serving our King together. Thank the Lord Pastor Miguel Trigozo, Haydee's husband, is helping us drive the van to bus our students to and from school, and their son Jonathan is helping us in our church in different ways, even preaching and doing our van route on Sundays along with Paul.

Thank the Lord He led us to find some new deaf people; Candelaria age 53 has no formal communication. She lives in a very small community. We brought her to church and she was thrilled, trying to copy the signs. Candelaria is smart but did not have the opportunity to learn sign language nor get an education. Please pray for her as we teach her from scratch; she is always busy working on her small farm. Luis, age 20, has no formal communication; we brought him to church and he was very thrilled to realize he could learn. Two of our students taught him a few signs. We thank the Lord for letting us find these precious deaf people to develop their language and teach them about Jesus. Giselle is 12 and her parents finally let us bring her to church. We pray they will let her attend our deaf school for her to learn faster. Giselle is very bright. We also led her stepsister to Christ on one of our visits.

Praise the Lord six deaf people who received the Lord, decided to get baptized in obedience to His command. Five of them have come to know Jesus with us in the last two years. They all started with almost no communication skills; they attend church and are also in our deaf school. The 6th one, Manuel, was saved years ago at Efata Baptist Church in Lima. He was in school when we served the Lord there in the mid 80s.

The Lord brought us to a very poor, old, sweet couple with a 53-year-old deaf crossed eyed daughter, Hermenegilda, who knows no sign language. The first time we visited them, the 86-year-old father received Jesus into his life. He cried and said, "God sent you all here to make me understand in a clear way how to receive the Lord." The following week, two of our deaf girls took time to start teaching Hermenegilda while my wife took time to share the Gospel with her mom who only speaks Quechua but understands a lot of Spanish. Using visual aids and some translation from her husband, Felicita was able to understand her condition and accepted our dear Lord into her life. She also cried and in her language as the husband interpreted, she shared how the Lord made her understand her need to receive Christ in a personal way. It was amazing to realize we were communicating in three languages with that precious family. Glory to God!

Eight of our students in our deaf school have received the Lord. Five of them have great potential for leadership. We praise the Lord for letting us train them now that they are saved and baptized. There is a long road and hard work ahead of us still. We pray God will raise servants from His work here; we need more help. It thrills my heart when I preach and see that the deaf who are faithful, understand the messages better as their learning increases.

Thank the Lord for every one of you who gets involved in praying and giving for the Lord's work. We greatly appreciate it; may the Lord provide for your every need as well.
