Dear Praying Friends,

In February, Mrs. Iris Green walked into our church. As she entered, April went back and began to talk with her. After a few minutes, I went and introduced myself to her. She began to tell me that when she saw the church sign, she walked by. Then when she saw Americans in the church, she was very excited. She began to tell me her story.

In the early 80's, she migrated to America. It wasn't long after living in the States that a US marine saw her and began to ask about her. They married but never had children. After many years of marriage, her husband died in 2024. Because of her own health, she needed to return to Taiwan to be close to family.

As she told me her story, I could tell she loved America. She did not want to return to Taiwan. At that time she had only been back in Taiwan a few weeks. I could tell she was missing home. She looked at us and was so very happy that Americans were there.

She told us, over the next few weeks during our Bible lessons, that she had never had the gospel shared with her before. She had been in America for over 40 years and never had someone share the gospel with her there. God brought her back to Taiwan so she could hear that God loves her. She has not yet accepted Jesus as her Saviour, but I believe she will soon. She is in church every time the doors are open. Please pray for Mrs. Iris Green to be saved soon.

Our annual teen summer camp was at the beginning of July. Because we are home on furlough and the campsite is a good four hours from our city, it did not look like our teens would be able to attend. However, a faithful couple in our church were willing to take a week off from their jobs to accompany the youth to camp. We praise God that the members of Hope Baptist Church have stepped up with willing hearts to fill in where it is needed.

Please continue to pray for Hope Baptist Church and our people there in Taiwan while we are back home on furlough. Please pray for our family as we travel to churches. Pray for safety and good health. When we return to Taiwan in October, we will need to find a new place to live. Please pray that God will open doors for us to find just what we need for our family of seven.
