(Lam. 3:22-23) We can certainly look back at our lives and see the faithfulness of God. Although our circumstances change, our God never changes. We can rest in this precious promise. Certainly, God continues to show His faithfulness in the ministry here in the Netherlands. We are thankful to God for all that He has accomplished.

We were able to hold our first meeting in the Netherlands. We scheduled a Gospel meeting in a town called Goes (pronounced "khoos"). We passed out over 1,000 flyers for this meeting. The Lord allowed us to rent a beautiful church building in which to hold the services. As we mentioned in our last letter, funding was provided for audio visual equipment which allowed us to offer translation in real time. We had 8 in attendance not including our family. In total, 13 people were present and heard the Gospel. We praise the Lord for allowing us to hold this meeting. We have another meeting scheduled for July 8. Please pray with us as we pass out 2,500 flyers for the next meeting. We will be meeting in the same building.



We have recently applied to continue homeschooling our children. In the Netherlands, children are required to enroll in and attend a Dutch school. They do not recognize homeschooling as a viable option with the exception of a few possible exemptions. Last year, we were able to claim religious differences with the schools in our area and were granted an exemption from enrolling in the Dutch school system. In recent weeks, the Dutch Supreme Court has ruled that fewer exemptions will be given. If our exemption is denied, we will be forced to enroll our children in a Dutch school or face prosecution. Please pray with us that our exemption will be approved.

I had the opportunity to preach in Belgium twice over the last few weeks. After preaching one Sunday morning, an Iranian man approached me to ask about salvation. The language barrier was great, but he professed understanding and belief in the finished work of Jesus on the cross for his sin. We are praying for his growth and for the Lord to use him to reach others with the Gospel. Praise the Lord!



We had a visit from a supporting Pastor in May. Pastor Benji Boone from Turning Point Baptist Church visited with his wife and youngest son. We had a wonderful time during their visit, and we were encouraged by them greatly.
