That question led to an opportunity to witness to them. We set up the counseling table again, opened our witnessing Bible, and all three of these young men accepted Christ as their Savior. We have had several others saved this first quarter. It is your prayers and faithful support that makes blessings like this possible. Thank you so much for trusting us to be there for you. Another prayer request for the market is for more Gospel tracts. With five on the team, we give out hundreds and hundreds of tracts every week.

Please continue to pray for Papua New Guinea. God continues to bless through the distribution of so many Bibles throughout that country. Revivals are taking place, young men and young women are surrendering to full time Christian ministry, and churches are being started in remote places. You gave, you prayed, and you sent someone to go where you couldn't go. Thank you for allowing me to be part of what God is doing in PNG. Please keep these dear believers in your prayers as they continue to spread the gospel in their own country.
