An Incredibly Blessed Winter

Dear Praying Family and Friends,

The past three months since our last update have been filled with answers to prayer, growth and gospel opportunities!

December was an exciting month for our family, as well as our church, as all of the Christmas events kept us very busy. In our last update we asked prayer for the following events:

Carol Service at Breck Road: God gave our church family such a sweet evening together as Scripture was read and carols were sung. Several visitors came along and the whole evening was a tender reminder of God's glorious gift of the Saviour. **Ladies' Christmas Gathering:** This year's gathering was the most well-attended ladies' event that we have had! We initially set up for 72 places, but by the time of the event, additional tables were being set out to make room for guests. The evening was very encouraging as women from each arm of ministry were represented: playgroup, English classes, Sunday School, Youth Rally, University ministry, etc. It was also very encouraging to have a great turn-out of men from the church willing to serve the tables and help with the clean-up after. **Carol Service at Norris Green:** What a night! The carol service at Norris Green saw the room nearly filled with visitors from door knocking and Bible club families. Various Christmas musical specials were shared by people from Breck Road and the Christmas account and gospel clearly given. We are still seeing fruit of prospects for the church from that carol service evening. Between the various Christmas services, we also held Christmas parties for the Youth Rally and English Classes. These both always prove to be sweet times for a real gospel emphasis. Something new that we did this year for Christmas was to go carolling in the city centre! Not only did this prove to be an enjoyable experience for our church, but hundreds of gospel tracts were distributed! It was well received by passers by and some even stopped to join us. On Christmas day we hosted several university students who were unable to go back to their countries and enjoyed a "Christmas Around the World" feast.

Bringing in the new year for our family in **January** looked a bit different. Through a long story and God's leading, we decided to spend the week leading up to the new year with some friends of ours in Morocco, North Africa. This experience was life-changing and eye-opening. Our children travelled tremendously and thankfully Joy's health (she was 6 months pregnant at the time) was well enough for the 4-day adventure. After that trip we can truly say "our eye hath affected our heart" and we are forever changed. Moreover, we are truly thankful to the Lord for the opportunity to have been able to see our friends and bring in the new year with them singing hymns and praying; all whilst in a predominantly muslim country. Upon our return to England, the new year saw the starting back of the various ministries that had been on "pause" for the Christmas break. It was sweet getting back into the rythmn of ministry and seeing the young people from the Sunday School and Bible Clubs, as well as the English Classes and other ministries we hold weekly. That month we also were able to add 6 new members to the church! On the heels of visiting Morocco, these opportunities of gospel service and the openness provided to us here is even more precious and we have been revived with urgency to truly "redeem the time" more fervently whilst we are able.

▶ THE BOY'S ARE CITIZENS!

In our last update we requested prayer for the application process of Wesley and Wyatt's citizenship. We rejoice to share that they have both received their documents are official dual citizens of the United States and the United Kingdom. Thank you so much to those who sacrificially gave towards this great need. We can now enter in and out of the county without any issues. Praise the Lord!

▶ UNIVERSITY MINISTRY God has opened a door!

Our last update requested prayer for the start of a ministry that was on or near one of the 5 universities in Liverpool. Through God's providence, a unique door was open to Breck Road just recently and the first Bible study was held on a Thursday! 20 people attended the first evening. Please keep this weekly Bible study and outreach opportunity in your prayer as we seek to be a beacon of God's light on the dark campuses of our city.

▶ NEW CHURCH PLANT Norris Green Baptist Church

The gospel work of Norris Green Baptist Church (our second church plant in a suburb of Liverpool) is truly advancing. God has been bringing in people from various walks of life to the Tuesday evening prayer meeting and Bible study. Countless conversations concerning salvation have been had with those who are beginning to attend regularly. Though no professions of faith have been shared as of yet, God is definitely stirring the hearts of the people and drawing them to Himself. The children's Bible club that meets each week on a Friday is also seeing growth. Just recently a church in England has given a 2010 transit minibus to the work of Norris Green Baptist Church! This is a tremendous blessing as we will now be able to use the minibus for lifts instead of our personal 9-seater. In addition to the new-to-us bus, God has also laid it on the heart of 2 people in our church to help with the driving of the bus routes for the Bible club each week. What a tremendous answer to prayer and blessing!



Men's Breakfasts

The men's breakfasts have been very well attended and a source of encouragement for the men of our church. Many from the church have brought in visitors and each talk has presented the gospel thoroughly. We are praying for godly men to come through for Him as a result.



Home-Education Group

The last 2 home-education days have been incredibly blessed! In January we had a guide dog charity come in and in February we had a Creation Research archeologist come give a talk. The children thoroughly enjoyed a dino-dig and holding dinosaur bones and fossils.



English Classes

In just the past 2 months we have seen more ESOL students come to the church services than ever before. A man from Hong Kong, has been especially attentive and taken the time to attend special events, as well. We've been able to speak to him more concerning the gospel.

February has been a month filled with much gospel advancement! The Sunday School at Breck Road has been growing numerically and spiritually. Close to 35 people (between families with children and single adults) stay each week to help with the Sunday School. We sometimes laugh saying it is as though we have a small restaurant on Sunday afternoons for lunch. Everyone has a role in the Sunday School hour and they joyfully fill it weekly. It's such a pleasure to serve alongside such precious people who we have seen God bring along throughout the years; some new, some former Sunday School children themselves, some university students, some whole families serving together. To see each volunteer grow in their faith, their love for children's ministry and each other is truly encouraging. The Sunday School is departmentalised into a teen class and then 4 other classes for those 11 and under. Each week our 5 minibuses bring in an average of 75-85 young people. Just the other week two of our workers had the privilege of speaking to a young man about salvation and he made a profession of faith. Praise the Lord! In a few days we are taking those who have earned points by bringing their Bibles and worksheets, attending faithfully and have memorised the Scripture passages on a special "Winter Party" outing...48 young people have earned enough points to attend!

February also brought the annual Crown Christian Heritage Trust Winter Retreat. This is a week-long conference held in a beautiful part of Wales that is designed to encourage the believer in their walk and provide ministry training and spiritual respite. This year's retreat saw nearly 200 in attendance. It is always a joy to gather with other believers and, although we assist with much of the planning and hosting, our own hearts were greatly blessed. Shortly after the Winter Retreat, Breck Road was able to help host a 2-day Answers in Genesis meeting for the Northwest. These meetings brought in several new visitors to church, as well as English class students and families from our home-ed group. The Monday following the AiG meetings we held our monthly home-education group featuring Creation Research UK. The representative for the UK gave a talk concerning creation, fossils and dinosaurs. 46 home-educated children were in attendance! Following the talk, the children enjoyed a dino-dig and playing together. Several good conversations were shared with the various parents in attendance, as well, that were used to point them to the Lord and speak of His work and their involvement. God has blessed this new ministry beyond what we had expected when He led us to begin it last year. It has brought families into the church services, the Sunday school and the playgroup. Please continue to pray for this special ministry. Apart from the numerous visitors being brought in each week via the door-to-door and open air evangelism, a big answer to prayer and highlight for February was the start of a university ministry. For seven years we have prayed for an open door for the universities- there are 5 in Liverpool. God saw fit to providentially answer this prayer this month through a series of incredible events and people. The first Bible study was held at a common-space between the two main universities just recently. 20 students from several different countries, walks of life and "beliefs" came out to the first evening! Praise the Lord! Please help us pray for this new beginning.

We stand at the entrance to the Spring months ready for warmth, but full of gratitude for how God is advancing His work here. We covet your prayers as growth means more demand physically, mentally and spiritually. We only want to advance on our knees, following the Lord in all things.
